Below is a list of recommended materials for several of the lesson plans for Camp this summer. Many of these items can be found in the home and can also be easily substituted. How we see the American West:

- For your paint you'll need –
 - Blueberries o Ground coffee
 - Water
 - Bowl
 - Coffee filters
 - Either a kettle or pot to heat your water
- For your brush you'll need one of these items below –
 - Used rag or washcloth
 - Strips of fabric or sponge
 - Twine o Cotton Balls
 - Coffee filters
- For the handle of your brush use either a clothespin or chip clip
- Painting surface –
 - You can use whatever you have available including
 - Cardboard
 - Paper
 - Fabric

Creating Rhythm:

To make your rattle you will need –

- Two paper plates
- Popsicle stick
- Stapler or glue
- Beads/buttons/or small rocks
- Markers, colored pencils, crayons, or natural paint from our American Art activity

Cowboy Myths & Music:

You'll need two metal or wooden spoons that have handles that fit easily in-between your fingers

Hardtack – a cowboy snack:

You'll need –

- Flour
- Water
- Rolling pin
- Toothpick
- Oven
- Cooking sheet
